Carroll has developed a dual career as a Registered Nurse and a prolific painter.

Realistic Expressionism best describes her work. She is a true colorist, creating art to initiate that second look, a pause by her painting, a pensive look by a viewer. Carroll's intuitive knowledge of people that she attained through years of nursing has been a light in the development of her portrait painting. Her interest in painting people began in New York at The Reilly League of Artists under Cesare Borgia. She continued developing life drawing skills at the Cultural Arts Program in Savannah while living on Hilton Head and attending SCAD for Children's Book Illustration. Her most recent inspiration came from studying under Robert Roark of Cape Cod, MA and attending a workshop with famous portrait artist Daniel E Greene of North Salem, NY.
